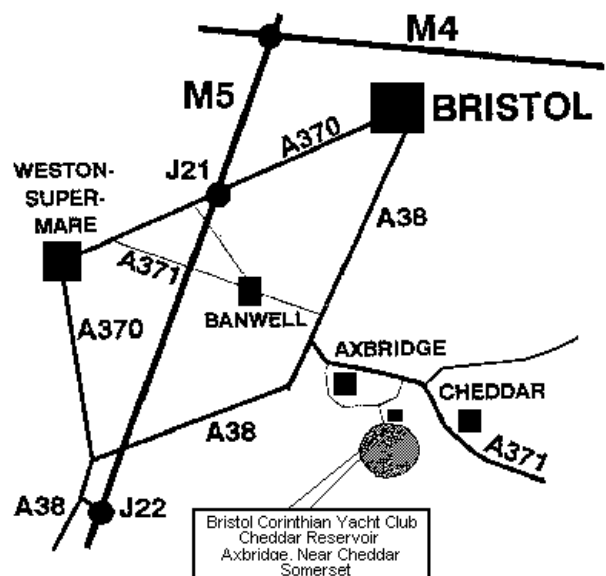

## **JUNIOR TOP CLUB EVENT Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2009**

I have your address as a contact within your club with regard to junior sailing. If you are not the right contact I would be most grateful if you could pass this letter on to the appropriate person.

I am writing to let you know that Bristol Corinthian Yacht Club will be holding its annual Junior Top Club event on Cheddar Reservoir at Axbridge. We would be delighted if your club is able to enter a team or teams.

The Junior Top Club is a handicap team event for children under 18 on the day of the event. Teams consist of three boats of any PY number. We regularly have Optimists, Mirrors, Toppers and various Lasers and have also had RSs, 420s, Buzz's and any other boats that clubs have chosen to use. Results are decided on the best two results of each member of the team and besides the overall Top Club Trophy there are prizes for younger age group teams and for individual performances and achievements not just results.

The event is managed to cater for all standards from the serious racers to those experiencing their first race. Often there is a large proportion of the fleet racing seriously for the first time. Besides a good fleet of safety boats there are usually boats available for coaching the novices. Race management ensures that the slower boats do not spend too long on the water by adjusting elapsed time based on number of laps completed.

The entry fee will be £10 per team. Lunch and Tea will be available and there is a bar for the supporting adults. Please bring as many boats as you can, we can always make up scratch teams so that everybody can take part. First start is at 11:00am.
