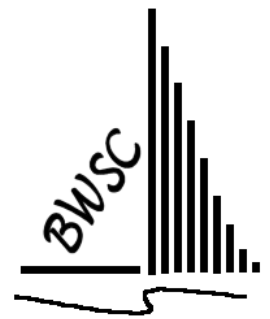

BOAT STORAGE – BWSC COMPOUND TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All members using the BWSC boat storage compound agree to observe the following requirements:

- Storage compound to be maintained in a clean and tidy condition and free from weeds and rubbish.
- Storage only for sailing dinghies and ancillary apparatus belonging to members of Baltic Wharf Sailing Club.
- Keep compound secure and prevent any attempt at trespass.
- Not to store boats or equipment in a dangerous manner.
- Not to cause a nuisance. All halyards and covers to be firmly secured.
- Members storing boats to maintain boat insurance and public liability insurance at all times.
- Not to cause obstruction or block access ways.
- Not to underlet or transfer storage rights from one member to another or attempt to transfer storage rights with the sale of boats. On cessation of club membership or sale of stored boats, storage rights will pass back to BWSC for re-allocation by the committee. Storage fees will be chargeable on a pro-rata quarterly basis for occupancy periods of less than one year.
- Members renting boat storage space in the BWSC compound undertake to compete in a minimum of 7 BWSC races in each calendar year.
- Any breaches of storage terms and conditions will be reviewed by BWSC committee.
